Welcome to FireQuest

FireQuest is a web based application that will allow us to log and track the smoke alarms that are installed by TFD.

The app will allow us to determine:

- Where alarms are installed
- How many alarms have been installed
- Who has installed alarms
- Whether installed alarms have saved lives during a fire

If you are on a 911 call...




First, enter or select the location of the install.

The program will auto populate a list of your most recent calls.

If you are on the scene of a 911 call select the current address listed.

If you are not on a 911 call...



If you are not on the scene of a 911 call, everything is the same, except that you will need to type the address of the location you are installing alarms.

Use the type address feature to enter the address manually.




